

## California “Cleaning Product Right to Know Act of 2017” Requirements Brief

### Product Labels: Deadline January 1, 2021:

- All intentionally added / functional ingredients
  - If a designated product label does not include a full list of intentionally added ingredients, it shall include all of the following:
    - (A) A statement that reads: “For more ingredient information visit”
    - (B) An address for an Internet Web site that provides all of the information required by Section 108954.5.
    - (C) A toll-free phone number.
- Fragrance allergens present at  $\geq 0.01\%$  (100 ppm) and a statement “Contains Fragrance Allergen(s)”
  - Fragrance non-allergens can be listed as “fragrance”
- Dyes can be listed as “colorants”
- Any functional ingredient on one of 22 designated lists.
- Toll free number and website URL
- Date or date code to be somewhere on the product container.

### Website: Deadline January 1, 2020

- Explanation of date code used on the product container
- Electronic links to all “Designated Lists” (all 22 of them) in a single location
- Link to the SDS sheet for all products
  - No more than 5 clicks from the URL listed on the product label
  - No more than 4 clicks from the product-specific web page.
- List of ingredients for a given product be available in easily printable format whether in the SDS or as a separate list (I suggest we use a separate list). NOTE: exact percentages, or ranges ,do not have to be revealed
  - Name of the ingredient
    - Ingredient naming conventions:
      - INCI name
      - IUPAC name
      - Chemical Abstracts Index name
      - Common name
    - Order of listing:
      - In descending order by weight for all ingredients present  $\geq 1\%$
      - In no particular order for ingredients present  $<1\%$
      - All fragrance ingredients present  $\geq 0.01\%$  whether they are an allergen or not.

- 1,4 dioxane must be listed if present  $\geq 0.001\%$  (10ppm)
- The CAS number of each ingredient, where it's not available list as "not available"
- The functional purpose served by each ingredient
- Nonfunctional ingredients present at 0.01% to be listed as well.

Note: everything here has to be in "electronically readable format" which means the information provided is all of the following:

- (1) Machine readable by automated systems, including, but not limited to, Web browsers, accessibility software to aid the disabled, automated scripts, and other software programs or applications.
- (2) Not restricted from access by search engines.
- (3) Not restricted from access by a requirement for registration, the provision of personally identifiable information, or the use of CAPTCHA or similar challenge response test technologies, whether visual, auditory, or otherwise.
- (4) Conforms to the most current version of the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) adopted by the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines Working Group of the World Wide Web Consortium.
